Professional Email Communications

In this day and age of instant communication, it is vital to send well-written emails to your growing network of peers, faculty, mentors and other influential people on your professional growth. Even with the use of mediums that require brevity, you still must come across as polished, professional and competent. Here are some general email etiquette guidelines.

- Say "please" and "thank you"
- Use proper grammar including commas, periods, capitalization, and correct spelling
- Do not use slang, curse words or overly cute language or icons
- Avoid abbreviations or instant messaging-type wording
- Monitor your inbox (and SPAM filter) to avoid missing important communications
- Treat all interactions through email, with the exception of your closest friends and family, as if you were talking to a prospective hiring manager at your ideal company
- Proofread the email before sending
- Wait until the email is composed and proofread before typing in the "To" email address

Email is a valuable tool for any job seeker, but you must remember that the way you execute an email will make an impression on the reader. Make sure you show your abilities and value by carefully and professionally composing your next email.
